## **REGULATIONS**

### **Competition goals:**

- \* To enhance pupils' solo performance skills, reveal their individual creativity and increase performance mastery
- \* To maintain the cooperation between the Republic's and foreign countries' music (art) school teachers and exchange their valuable pedagogical practice experience.

### **Competition terms:**

\* Only violin and cello solo students of non-formal education institutions (music and art schools) are eligible to enter this competition.

### **Competitors are divided into 4 groups according to grades:**

- A 1st - 2nd grades** - programme up to 5 min.
- B 3rd - 4th grades** - programme up to 7 min.
- C 5th - 6th grades** - programme up to 10 min.
- D 7th - 8th (and higher) grades** - programme up to 12 min.

### **Programme:**

\* The contestants perform  
**2 different character pieces of their choice (one must be virtuosic).** The pieces must be performed from memory.

### **Competition jury:**

\* All performances will be evaluated by the jury whose names will be announced before the competition. The jury verdict is not appealable.

### **Evaluation and prizes:**

- \* All contestants and their teachers will receive Certificate of Appreciation
- \* The best performers of every group will be awarded with diplomas and laureate diplomas.
- \* There will also be diplomas with special nominations:  
„**The youngest performer of the contest**”  
„**Quick fingers**” - for the most technical virtuoso piece  
„**Singing Strings**” - for the most musical lyric piece.

### **General terms and conditions:**

\* All applications must meet the contest regulations, otherwise, they will not be accepted.

\* The deadline for submitting the applications is **February 15th, 2019.**
