



VII international competition of young pianists „My childhood friend – piano”

REGULATIONS

ORGANIZERS

- Janina Misciukaitė School of Art.

PLACE AND TIME

- Competition will take place on 2nd December, 2021 in Janina Misciukaitė School of Art, address Zeimių str. No. 6, Jonava, phone No. +370 (349) 51870.

PARTICIPANTS

- The competition is open to young pianists from educational institutions complementing formal education;
- Grand Prix winners of previous international competitions "My childhood friend - piano" are not eligible to compete.

Participants of competition are divided into three groups according to classes:

- A 1 – 3 classes** – programme until 5 min.
- B 4 – 5 classes** – programme until 7 min.
- C 6 – 8 classes** – programme until 10 min.

REPERTOIRE

Participants perform two freely chosen plays of different character and different epochs:

- A work from Baroque epoch;
- XX – XXI century work.

Programme is performed by heart.

JURY

- The composition of the jury will be announced before the competition;
- The decisions of jury are final and cannot be changed.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- Fee for participant of competition is 25 €. The fee is not refunded for non-attendance;

- Professional development certificates will be issued for educators (price is 5 € and is paid on arrival).
- All competition performances are open to the public. Organizers have all rights to records of competition participants without any additional payments.
- For the purpose of informing the public, the competition will be photographed and filmed, so the participants of the competition can be seen in the photos and videos of the event. Photos and videos of the participants can be published on the organizer's website and on social network accounts and distributed in various media informing about the competition. **Acceptance of this condition is the participant's application.**
- The competition is organized in accordance with the decisions of the Minister of Health of the Republic of Lithuania, the Head of State Operations of the State Emergency Situation and legal acts on the organization of events, taking into account the COVID - 19 epidemic situation in Lithuania.
- If the government of the Republic of Lithuania announces quarantine or bans / restricts public events, the competition will be organized remotely. Then the conditions and procedure for organizing the competition will be additionally published on the school's website, social networks and information will be sent by e-mail.
- Schedule of competition, exact list of participants, time of rehearsal and performances will be announced on **25th November, 2021, in school's website www.jmm.lt**, also information will be sent by email for those addressees who sent their requests by email.

EVALUATION AND AWARDS

- Performers of each age group are awarded diplomas and prizes of I, II and III places.
- 1 Grand Prix is awarded;
- Separate nominations are intended for the best performers of works of Baroque epoch and XX-XXI century composers;
- All educators of competitors are awarded by letter of thanks.
